

Confirmed DVT (Warfarin-Enoxaparin Pack)

Provider Discharge Check List

DVT Diagnosed (Check USS report)

Enoxaparin (Clexane) administered and ongoing arrangements made:

Options:

1. Patient to self-administer (SANOFI pamphlet for instructions) **OR**
2. General Practice Team to administer **OR**
3. District Nurses – complete DNS referral form and fax to (06) 350 8102 including copy of Enoxaparin (Clexane) Administration form chart **OR**
4. Another provider – please fax patient info including copy of Enoxaparin (Clexane) administration prescription

Warfarin or Dabigatran provided if no exclusion or allergies - **never use Dabigatran and Enoxaparin (Clexane) at the same time. It is important that the person receives 5 doses of therapeutic Enoxaparin (Clexane) prior to commencing Dabigatran on day 6**

Patient given anticoagulation education including:

1. Warfarin / Dabigatran patient information pamphlet
2. "I have a clot" pamphlet
3. Day 4 INR instruction form and patient aware of follow-up arrangement including how to obtain results:
 - o if patient is confirmed DVT on Wednesday or Thursday please phone Haematology to organise plan for INR – 06 350 8553 or 027 240 8254)
4. Blood test form – which clearly states that patient is for GPT dosing or Haematology dosing (**NOTE: MedLab will not do dosing whilst patient is on Enoxaparin**)
5. Red anticoagulation book
