## Advice on starting the progestogen-only implant (FSRH Guidelines)

|   | Any other time; consider pregnancy   | 7 days  |
| Women who are amenorrhoeic                                  | At any time if it is reasonably certain she is not pregnant                                  | 7 days  |
| Postpartum (includes any delivery from 24 weeks' gestation) | On or before Day 21 postpartum   | Not required  |
|   | After Day 21 postpartum  | 7 days (unless menstruation recommenced and Days 1–5)         |
| Post first- or second-trimester abortion                    | Up to and including Day 5 postabortion   | Not required  |
|   | At any other time if it is reasonably certain she is not pregnant<br>or at risk of pregnancy | 7 days  |
| Following oral emergency contraception                      | Immediately following administration   | 7 days after levonorgestrel, 14 days after ulipristal acetate |
| Other situations in which pregnancy cannot be excluded      | Consider quick starting implant or bridging method   | 7 days  |
